

The first implantable human surveillance microchip is here!

Approved by the FDA in 2004, VeriChip is a radio frequency computer chip that is inserted under the skin, usually in the upper right arm, through an outpatient procedure. Approximately the size of a grain of rice, the chip transmits a 16-digit identification number picked up by a VeriChip reader or scanner. Once the scanner picks up the ID number, it is then connected to a government database containing a myriad of personal information on the individual, including medical, financial, and other confidential data.

Manufactured by Digital Angel headquartered in Delray Beach, Florida, VeriChip commercializes its mission, “Identify, Locate, and Protect” and has become highly recognized in business, medical, and government sectors across the world. Digital Angel located in Denmark, United Kingdom, and South America has made its leading mark on the global markets, not only with VeriChip, but also GPS (Global Positioning Satellite) tracking, pet and livestock identification, and monitoring devices for the elderly, infants, and health care industry.

In 2004 the parent company of VeriChip and Digital Angel, Applied Digital Solutions, joined forces with ORBCOMM, a global satellite communications company, to incorporate GPS devices into the human chip. VeriChip will use the company’s 29 low-earth orbiting satellites and infrastructure to globally channel data on individuals’ whereabouts.

Sources say there is a “Bilderberger” plan to microchip every person-worldwide by 2017. Western Europe (EU) has already started micro-chipping their citizens.

Our safety and protection is not the priority, but to have everyone--one way or another—under surveillance.
